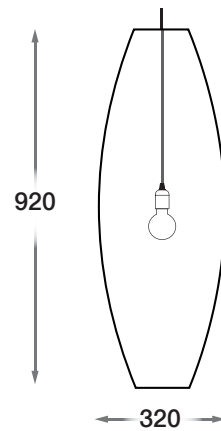
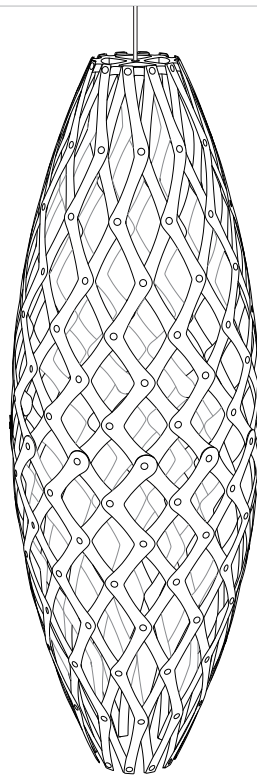


12 Fitting of the bulb holder and cord is most visually striking if the bulb is centred within the light as shown. Once the bulb holder is sitting where desired, thread the cord grip up tightly.



13 The light must be installed by a qualified Electrician - DO NOT attempt to install it yourself. A bulb holder with electric cord is included but a bulb is not supplied. A large frosted globe bulb looks best e.g. 23 watt (max) compact fluorescent bulb (eco bulb).

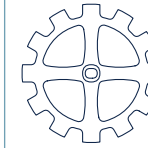

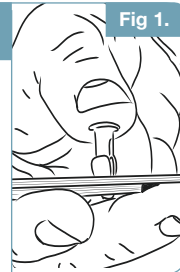

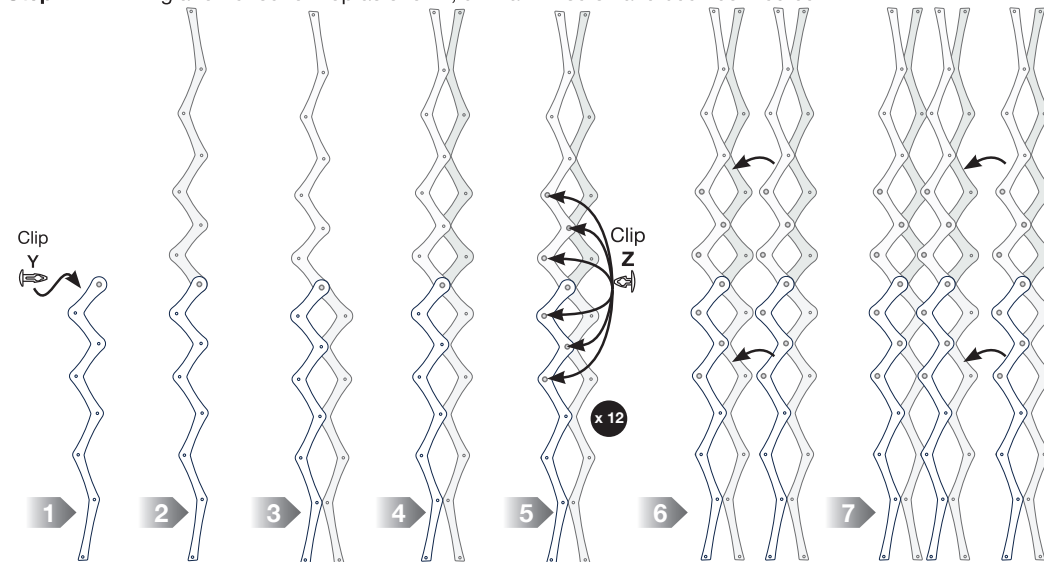
Hinaki Shape x 52 which includes 4 spares

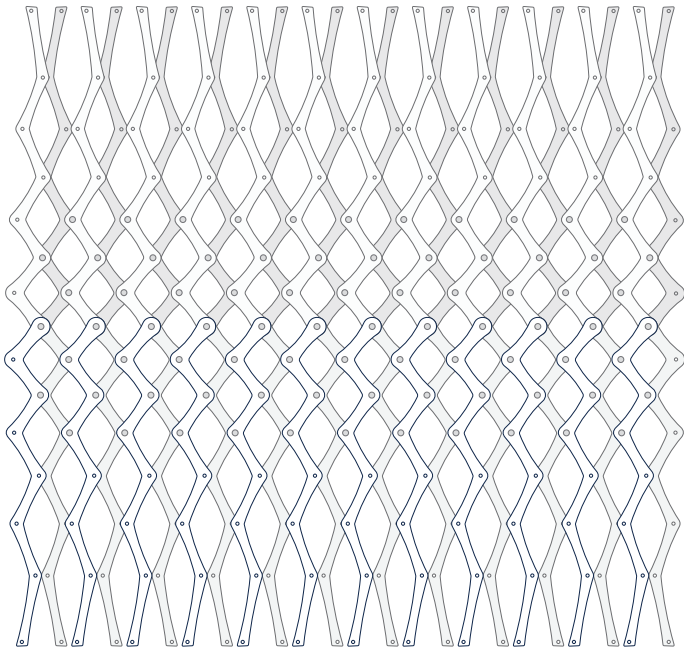
BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Take out the 4 spares and set aside.
- Take note of the helpful diagram to the right showing the importance of supporting the rear of the hole when inserting clips.
- A pair of gloves is recommended to prevent splinters.
- Assembly takes around: 45 minutes



- Step 1** - Take one shape and orientate it as shown.
- Take a long clip Y and press it through the top hole.
- Step 2** - Flip a second shape and clip this underneath the first shape.
- Support the rear of the shape as shown in Fig 1.
- Step 3** - Flip a third shape, clipping it under the first two.
- Step 4** - Flip a fourth shape, clipping this under the first three.
- Step 5** - Insert clip Z into the 6 holes where shown. Make 12 of these sets x 12
- Step 6** - Bring a second set from the right and lay it on top of the first, then clip together. This creates an over under, over under pattern.
- Step 7** - Bring another set on top as shown, until all 12 sets have been connected.

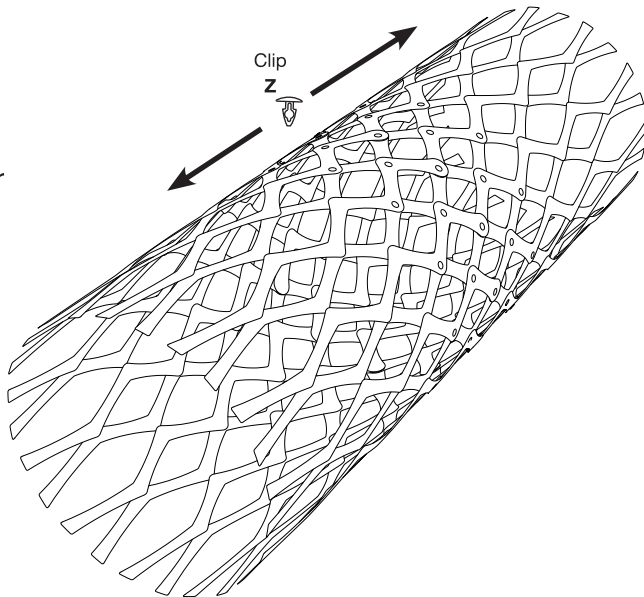




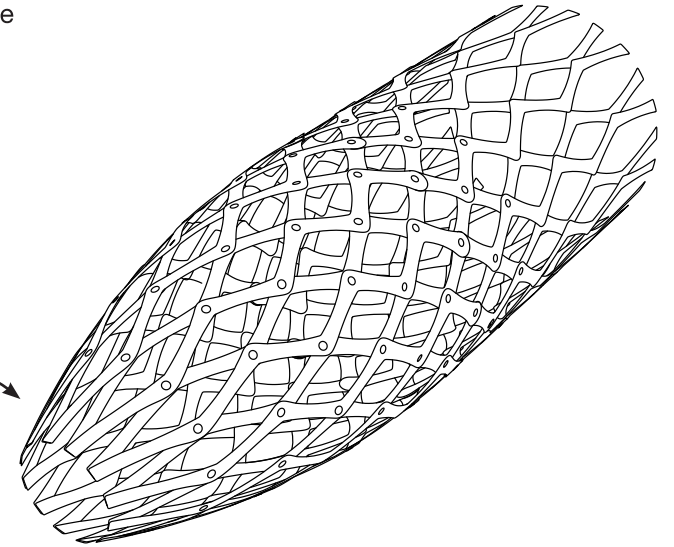
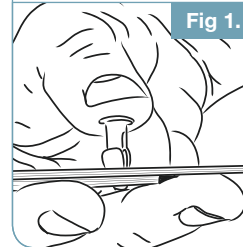
8 Carefully flip this over so the clips are with their points up.

9 Bring the two ends together and clip together in the same places as step 6.

Be sure to keep the same over/under pattern. Start clipping your light together using clip Z. It's best to start in the middle of the light and work outwards.



10 Be very careful putting the last clips into the end. The bamboo needs to be supported at the back with two fingers. Fig 1.



11 Fix the bulb holder into the top as shown, threading the cord grip together loosely. Take this top with the cord and fit into the light by using clip Z. Ensure the recess in the top is facing towards the ceiling. Fig 2.
