MOUNTING ON THE FIXTURE

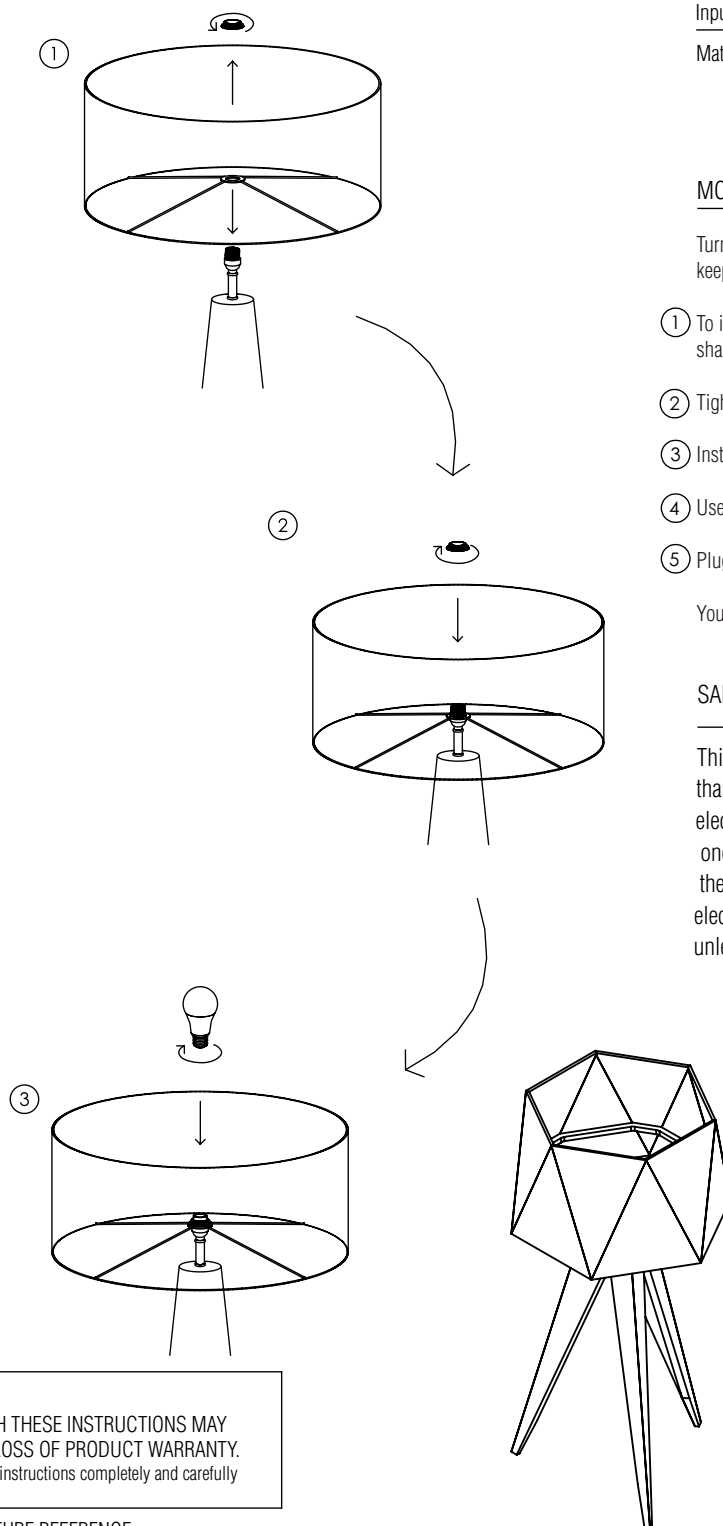
Turn off the electrical power before starting the installation, and keep it turned off until the installation is completed.

- 1 To install the shade, unscrew the socket nut, and insert the shade into the socket.
- 2 Tighten the socket nut to lock the shade to the socket.
- 3 Install an E26 bulb on the socket, with maximum 25W rating.
- 4 Use the switch on the power cord to turn the luminaire on/off.
- 5 Plug the luminaire into a proper outlet.

Your luminaire is ready for use.

SAFETY WHEN CONNECTING TO THE MAINS

This luminaire has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with adapters or extension cords unless the plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.
