INSTALL FIXTURE

CAUTION: BE SURE POWER IS OFF AT THE MAIN BREAKER BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

CAUTION: INSTALLATION REQUIRES 2 PEOPLE

- 1. Carefully unpack all items from the upper section of the crate. In the upper section you will find:
 - Canopy/Gripper Plate Assembly
 - Hardware Kit
 - Cables
 - · Canopy Cover Plate

CAUTION: DO NOT REMOVE GLASS FROM BOXES OR STICKERS FROM THE FIXTURE. LABELING OF THESE PIECES IS CRITICAL TO A SUCCESSFUL INSTALL.


2. Locate the canopy/gripper plate assembly.



CANOPY GRIPPER PLATE ASSEMBLY

3. Unscrew (12) 1/4-20 screws and (4) 8-32 shoulder bolts. Remove bolts, screws and lockwashers and retain for later use.

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4. Separate gripper plate from canopy and set aside.



5. Thread the wires in the electical box through one of the center holes in the canopy.





CAUTION: THIS FIXTURE IS VERY HEAVY. INDIVIDUAL BUILDING AND STRUCTURAL CONDITION PRESENT UNIQUE REQUIREMENTS AND CONSULTATION WITH A STRUCTURAL ENGINEER IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED. DRILLING ADDITIONAL HOLES FOR MOUNTING SCREWS MAY BE REQUIRED.

- 6. Attach canopy to solid framing member in at least 6 places, distributing the load evenly. It may be necessary to add additional framining members to adequately and evenly support this heavy fixture. We've supplied 5/16" x 2 1/2"lag screws with your fixture, however, different materials and/or construction methods may require different fasteners.
- 7. Unpack fixture from the middle section of the crate.
- 8. Move fixture into place under canopy. Orient fixture in desired position regarding cloth covered supply wires.
- 9. Thread (4) cables into fixture cable mounting block.




10. Locate canopy cover plate, Orient plate with screws pointing up. Feed (4) cables and (1) cloth covered supply wire through canopy cover plate. Place a protective layer on top of the fixture, to prevent scratching. Rest canopy cover plate on top of the protective layer on the fixture.



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- 11. Locate gripper plate.
- 12. Orient gripper plate so that studs and the knurled side of the cable grippers are facing down.
- 13. Loosen nuts on strain relief and cable grippers.




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14. Feed cables through grippers. Feed the cloth covered supply wire through the strain relief.



15. Attach gripper plate to the canopy using lockwashers, 1/4-20 screws and 8-32 shoulder bolts.

- 16. Unscrew (2) 8-32 nuts from the canopy cover plate.
- 17. Raise canopy cover plate and attach lanyards to the studs. Secure with the 8-32 nuts.



CAUTION: LIFTING OF FIXTURE REQUIRES 2 PEOPLE

- 18. Lift fixture and push cables into grippers. Raise fixture to desired height.
- 19. Gently apply downward pressure to fixture to help set cable tension.
- 20. Level fixture and balance tension between all 4 cables. Fixture can be lowered by supporting fixture and then pressing in plunger on gripper and allowing cables to slide out.

CAUTION: HEIGHT AND LEVEL OF FIXTURE MAY NOT BE ADJUSTED AFTER THIS POINT. GLASS MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE ADJUSTING FIXTURE HEIGHT.

- 21. Tighten nuts on strain relief and cable grippers. Be sure fixture is supported by the cables not the cloth covered supply wire. For best appearance, push cloth covered supply wire up into the canopy until it is taut.
- 22. Using suitable wire connectors (not provided), connect fixture wires to supply wires (white to white and black to black). Connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper or green) together.

Caution: Make sure wire connectors are twisted on securely and no bare wires are exposed.

23. The ground wire is shipped to you installed near the center opening. The ground wire can be moved to the stud near either of the other two openings if necessary.


24. This fixture uses 63 pieces of glass. Each piece of glass is boxed individually and labeled with a part number. Each piece of glass also has a blue dot placed on it. The dot will be used to help in describing glass orientation in these instructions. Each piece of glass has a glossy side and a matte side. The blue dot has been placed on the glossy side.

25. The fixture has been labeled to help with glass installation. Each arm is numbered and/or labeled with letters indicating where the glass is to be installed.

SAMPLE LABEL




LABEL INDICATES LOCATION OF GLASS

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




ANGLE THE GLASS AND SLIDE IT UP BETWEEN THE TWO BARS




LONG EDGE OF GLASS RESTS AGAINST THIS BAR




NOTCH IN GLASS SITS ON THIS BAR

















- 27. Gripper knurled nuts may have loosened during glass installation. Re-check that gripper knurled nuts are tight.
- 28. Attach canopy cover plate using the (6) barrel nuts.
- 29. Restore electricity at main breaker.
