
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

INSTRUCTIONS

I. Preparing the Fixture

- 1. Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2. Feed the fixture wires from the socket assembly through the center hole of the fixture frame and the fixture loop.
- 3. Insert the stem of the socket assembly through the center hole of the fixture frame.
- 4. Secure the fixture loop on the fixture frame.
- 5. Determine the desired height of the fixture and adjust the chain accordingly by doing the following:
 - a) Remove a portion of the chain by opening a link with pliers.
 - b) Install the bottom end of chain onto the fixture loop using a quick link.
 - c) Unscrew the collar nut from the screw collar and slide it onto the chain, followed by the canopy.
 - d) Then install the chain onto the canopy loop with a quick link.
- 6. Weave the cord through the chain, collar nut, canopy loop, canopy, and out of the junction box.
- 7. Trim the cord, leaving enough length to make electrical connections.

II. Wiring the Fixture

- 1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
 - a) Hot fixture wire to hot power line wire
 - b) Neutral fixture wire to neutral power line wire
- 4. Carefully tuck all the wires behind the mounting bar into the junction box.

III. Installing the Fixture

- 1. Place the canopy onto the mounting plate and secure it in place by screwing the collar nut tightly onto it.
- 2. Install the candle tubes over the sockets.
- 3. Screw the lamps into the sockets to finish. Refer to the socket labels for max wattage information.

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
