


INSTRUCTIONS

I. Preparing the Fixture

- 1. Separate the mounting plate from the canopy and install it over the junction box using the mounting screws.
- 2. Determine the desired height of the fixture and complete the stem assembly by screwing the stems together.
- 3. Feed the fixture wires through the stem assembly, collar nut, canopy, and half ball.
- 4. Slide the half ball of the assembled fixture onto the mounting plate.
- 5. Spread the fixture arms evenly.

II. Wiring the Fixture

- 1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
 - a) Hot fixture wire (black/smooth) and hot power line wire from the junction box (hot to hot)
 - b) Neutral fixture wire (white/textured) and neutral power line wire from the junction box (neutral to neutral)
- 4. Carefully tuck all the wires behind the mounting plate into the junction box.

III. Installing the Fixture

- 1. Mount the canopy onto the mounting plate and secure it in place by screwing the collar nut tightly onto it.
- 2. Secure the shades to the sockets by screwing the socket rings tightly onto them.
- 3. Screw the bulbs into the sockets. Refer to the socket label for max wattage information.
