



## **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### I. Preparing the Fixture

- 1. Separate the mounting plate from the canopy by removing the fixture screws.
- 2. Install the mounting plate to the junction box and secure it using the mounting screws.

#### II. Wiring the Fixture

- Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
  - a) Hot fixture wire to hot power line wire
  - b) Neutral fixture wire to neutral power line wire
- 4. Carefully tuck all the wires into the junction box.

#### III. Installing the Fixture

- 1. Mount the canopy onto the mounting plate and secure it in place by installing the fixtures screws.
- 2. Screw the bulbs into the sockets. Refer to the socket label for max wattage information.
- 3. To finish, hang the hooks of the shade assembly pieces around the top and bottom fixture rings.
