





INSTRUCTIONS

I. Preparing the Fixture

- 1. Remove the mounting plate from the fixture base.
- 2. Install the mounting plate to the junction box and secure it using the mounting screws.

II. Wiring the Fixture

- Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity
 running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
 - a) Hot fixture wire (black) to hot power line wire from the junction box (hot to hot)
 - b) Neutral fixture wire (white) to neutral power line wire from the junction box (neutral to neutral)
- 4. Carefully tuck all the wires into the junction box.

II. Installing the Fixture

- 1. Mount the fixture base onto the mounting plate and secure it in place by installing the fixture screws.
- 2. Screw the bulbs into the sockets. Refer to the socket labels for max wattage information.
- 3. Secure the glass panels to the fixture frame with the clips and clip screws.
- 4. Use the frame screws to secure the fixture frame to the fixture base.
- 5. For wet locations, caulk around the base of the fixture with waterproof construction sealant.
