INSTRUCTIONS

I. Preparing the Fixture

1. Separate the mounting plate from the fixture backplate and secure it to the junction box with the mounting screws.

II. Wiring the Fixture

- 1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits to ensure there's no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 3. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
 - a) Hot fixture wire to hot power line wire
 - b) Neutral fixture wire to neutral power line wire
- 4. Carefully tuck all the wires behind the mounting plate into the junction box.

III. Installing the Fixture

- 1. Mount the fixture onto the mounting plate and secure it in place using the fixture screws.
- 2. Install the socket plate(s) onto the socket(s).
- 3. Place the shade(s) over the socket(s) and secure them with the counter ring(s) using the tool.
- 4. Screw the bulb(s) into the socket(s). Refer to the socket label for max wattage information.
