

SUSPENSION INSTRUCTIONS

Turn OFF the electrical power before starting the installation, and keep it turned off until the installation is completed.

This assembly may require the work of two people so it can be secure and well executed.

- (01) Remove the protecting package from the pieces taking care to not harm any parts with cutting surfaces or objects. Lay the parts of the fixture on some horizontal surface in order to connect them, if needed use the protecting package to soften the surface and protect the parts from getting scratched or harmed.
- (02) Next, pass the steel cables through the cable anchors fixed on the fixture The support cable excess must go inside the
- Adjust the height and the level of the pendant by pressing the lower tip of the cable anchors, next, roll or cut the steel cable excess. If the steel cables are cut, notice that the height adjustment will be limited.

MAKING ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

O4 Insert the cable coming from the pendant into the canopy through the strain relief (S), adjust the appropriate height and tighten the screw on the strain relief to anchor the cable.

The cable from the pendant that enters the canopy was two internal wires, BLACK and WHITE.


The BLACK wire from the cable corresponds to the Positive terminal of the LED, and must be connected to the Positive wire coming from the driver, the RED wire.

The WHITE wire from the cable corresponds to the Negative, terminal of the LED, and must be connected to the Negative wire coming from the driver, the BLUE (or BLACK) wire.

- I Connect the <u>Positive</u> wire from the single cable (Black), to the <u>Positive</u> wire from the <u>Driver</u> (Red), using the marked (+) Wago connector.
- II Connect the <u>Negative</u> wire from the single cable (White), to the <u>Negative</u> wire from the <u>Driver</u> (Blue or Black), using the marked (-) Wago connector.
- Using the white flat 3 core cable that exits the driver's enclosure, make the electrical connections to the mains supply, in accordance with all safety standards and local electrical codes. This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product, and the hazards involved.
- 66 Screw the junction box cover (J) and structural base (B) in the junction box using the provided screws (S1).
- Once the structural base (B) is fixed in the ceiling, insert the excess energy cable in the junction box and fit the canopy (C) in the structural base, pushing it against the ceiling and rotating it until it locks. Fasten the provided screw (S2) to secure it.

Turn on the electrical power.

The luminaire is ready for use.
