


ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE

Read carefully all the assembling instructions below, before starting the installation process:


- Remove the protecting package from the pieces taking care to not harm any parts with cutting surfaces or objects. Lay the parts of the fixture on some horizontal surface, if needed use the protecting package to soften the surface and protect the parts from getting scratched or harmed.
- 2 Notice that the fixture has three parts which are joined by one articulated point. The frame (F1), frame (F2) and frame (F3), must be correctly positioned and mounted by the user, throught the following steps:
- (3) Carefully slide the frames (F2) and (F3) alligning both through the holes in which will be threaded the provided screws.

 Before sliding the frames, slightly lift them up so that the friction between them doesn't harm the surface of the fixture.
- 4 After all the frames are correctly alligned through the holes, insert the metallic support (S) between the frame 3 (F3) and frame 2 (F2), alligning it with the holes on both frames.
- (5) Use the plastic tubes (T) to guide the screws to their holes and prevent them to fall into the frames, then fasten the provided screws (S1 and S2) fixing both frames. After securing the screws, remove the guiding tubes.
- 6 After the screws are tight, fixing all the frames together, fix the frames to the base fastening the provided screws (S1).





- (7) Once the fixture is assembled, position it on the ceiling to assure the correct orientation before starting the installation.
- (8) As soon as the position of the piece is decided, place the drilling template (G) on the ceiling and secure it with tape. Then, bring the light fixture to the template to ensure the hole positions are correct. Once the correct positions of the template and the light fixture are determined, make marks on the ceiling where the metal supports will be installed. Next, use an 8mm drill bit to make the holes and insert the plastic anchors into the ceiling. Note that the circle on the canopy should be located below the junction box.
- (9) Fix the metallic supports on the ceiling fastening the provided screws (S3).
- (10) Once the supports are fixed in the ceiling, bring the fixture close to the junction box and make all electrical connecticons according to all applicable local codes. Insert the excess energy cable inside the junction box.
- (11) Fit the fixture in the metallic supports, installed on the ceiling, by rotating it counterclockwise until it locks.
- (12) Insert the covers on top of the fixture, close to the metallic supports, to avoid light leak.

Turn ON the energy power, your luminaire is ready for use.
