



ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE

Read carefully all the assembling instructions below, before starting the installation process:

- 1 Remove the protecting package from the pieces taking care to not harm any parts with cutting surfaces or objects. Lay the parts of the fixture on some horizontal surface, if needed use the protecting package to soften the surface and protect the parts from getting scratched or harmed.
- ② Notice that the fixture is disassembled in three separate parts which are wrapped with the protecting package. The frame (F1), frame (F2) and frame (F3), must be assembled together by the user, throught the following steps:
- (3) Allign the frame (F2) with the frame (F1) through the holes in which will be threaded the provided screws, carefully inserting the energy cable along with the connector inside the base (B).
- 4 Use the plastic tubes (T) to guide the screws to their holes and prevent them to fall into the frames, then fasten the provided screws (S1) fixing both frames. After securing the screws, remove the guiding tubes.
- (5) Repeat the same process aligning the frame (F3) with the frame (F2), inserting it's energy cable inside the base (B).
- (6) Repeat step number 4.



- (7) Join the connectors from the frames with their relative terminals.
- (8) Use the template to make the markings on the ceiling where the holes must be made.
- Use 8mm drills and make the holes. Next insert the plastic bushings and screw the metallic supports using the provided screws (S3).
- (i) Bring the fixture next to the ceiling and make all electrical connections according to all applicable local codes. Insert the excess energy cable inside the junction box.
- (1) Fix the junction box cover on the junction box using the provided screws (S2).
- (2) Raise the fixture against the ceiling and fit it in the metallic supports, fixed on the ceiling.
- (13) Insert the covers on top of the fixture, close to the metallic supports, to avoid light leak.
- 14 Turn ON the energy power, your luminaire is ready to use.

WHEN INSTALLING THE FIXTURE IN THE WALL, DO NOT POSITION THE FIXTURE WITH THE MOUNTING HOLES ORIENTED AS SHOWED IN THE DIAGRAM, THE SMALLER OPENING MUST BE POINTING DOWN/SIDEWAYS FOR THE FIXTURE TO BE CORRECTLY FIT AND STAY SECURED.
