INSTALLING THE FIXTURE ON CEILING

Turn off the electrical power before starting the installation, and keep it turned off until the installation is completed.


This assembly may require the work of two people so it can be secure and well executed.

- ① Choose the position in which the fixture shall be installed, and mark on the ceiling the holes for the suspension cables. The average distance between the cables is 31 inches.
- ② Make the holes in the ceiling using an 8mm drill, and insert the plastic bushings on them.
- ③ Pass the (S1) screw through the cable gripper cover and fixate them into the plastic bushings previously installed.
- ④ Insert the suspension cable on the cable gripper, leaving the ball-end inside of it, to anchor the luminaire.
- ⑤ Insert the two suspension cables coming from the fixture into the cable joiner, one on each side. Align and level the luminaire, and tighten the screw at the bottom of the cable joiner to secure the cables to it. Repeat this process for the other 2 cables on the opposite side of the luminaire. Once the luminaire is level, cut the cable excess.
- ⑥ Insert the tip of the suspension cable installed on the ceiling on the top of the cable joiner. To insert the cable and adjust the height, press the tip of the gripper while simultaneously sliding the cable in. When you release it, the gripper will lock the cable and anchor the fixture. Repeat this process with all the grippers, adjusting the height and leveling the fixture.

ADJUSTING THE FIXTURE HEIGHT

Choose the height (H) you want the luminaire to hang below the ceiling by pushing on the anchor to release tension. While pressing the tip, move the cable until it reaches the desired length. Release the tip and the cable will be locked again. Final adjustments can be made after the fixture is mounted.

Now you are ready to make the electrical connection.




INSTALLING THE FIXTURE ON CEILING

- 7 Using an 8 mm drill, make the holes on the ceiling to fixate the canopy support base. Then, insert the plastic bushings on the holes.
- 8 Pass the power cables through the junction box cover (JB) and support base (B).
- 9 Make the electrical connections in compliance with all the safety standards and local electrical codes. This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product, and the hazards involved.
- 10 Using the (S2) screws, fixate the junction box cover (JB) into the junction box, and with the (S1) screws, fixate the support base (B) into the bushings previously installed in the ceiling. Make sure they are tight and secured.
- 11 Bring the canopy close to the support base (B), fit them together, and using the (S3) finishing screws, fixate the canopy in the support base. Be sure everything is well secured.

Turn on the electrical power.

The luminaire is ready for use.
