
To Mount Fixture to Wall (Figure 1)

Component Parts

- A Wall Mount Bracket
- B Anchors
- C #10 Screws
- D Fixture Assembly
- E #8 Black Screws
- F Green Ground Screw
- G Cupped Washer

Caution: Be sure power is off at the main breaker box prior to installation.

- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture from the carton.
- 2. Center the wall mount bracket (A) over the electrical box being sure to hold it plum and level. If the wall mount bracket has a notch orient bracket with notch at the bottom.

Put the wall mount bracket down and drill 1/4" holes in the locations marked on the wall. For holes using anchors, place the tapered end of the anchors (B) into the holes and gently tap them flush to the wall using a light weight hammer.

- 3. Thread the wires in the electrical box through the center hole in the wall mount bracket (A) while moving the bracket into position. Using the 1" #10 screws (C), screw the bracket securely to the wall. Be careful not to overtighten or strip the anchors.
- 4. Thread the black # 8 screws (E) up through the holes in the top of the wall mount bracket (A). Leave the bottom screws out for now.
- 5. Hold the fixture assembly (D) close to the wall mount bracket and using suitable wire connectors (not provided), connect fixture wires to supply wires (white to white or ribbed and black to black or smooth, and bare copper or green to bare copper or green). Ground the mounting bracket using the green ground screw (F) and cupped washer (G) to secure a pigtail lead to the bracket.
- 6. Carefully tuck all wires behind the fixture assembly and inside the wall mount bracket and place the fixture over the bracket so that the screws in the top of the wall bracket go through the holes in the top of the fixture. Secure the fixture by threading the remaining black #8 screws up through the holes in the bottom of the fixture and into the mounting bracket.


Caution: Make sure wire connectors are twisted on securely, and no bare wires are exposed.







To Install Bulb and Front Panel (Figures 2 & 3)

Component Parts

- D Fixture Assembly
- H Socket
- I Bulb (Included)
- J Bulb Shield
- K Front Plate (12-6401 is glass, 12-6403 is a forged plate)
- 1. Install light bulbs (I). Be careful not to touch bulb with bare hands; oil from the hands will dramatically reduce bulb life.
- 2. Thread bulb shield (J) onto socket (H) (bulb shield will only thread on 3 to 4 threads). Future bulb changes may be accomplished by snapping glass portion of barrier on and off rather than unthreading the holder.
- 3. Slip plate or glass (K) into tabs of fixture assembly (D) aligned so equal amounts protrude on both sides.
