
Installation Instructions

For Contract Antasia Table Lamps 272803 & 272803C


To Install Shade (Figures 1 & 2)

Component Parts

- A Shade
- B Diffuser
- C Washer
- D Finial
- E Harp
- F Harp Holder
- 1. Carefully unpack the lamp from the carton.
- 2. Remove finial (D) and washer (C) from threaded stud on harp (E) and save for later use. *Finial and washer are shipped installed.*
- Squeeze harp (E) together while holding the locks up towards the top of the harp (E) and slip into harp holder (F) (Figure 1).
- 4. Allow locks to slip down harp (E) and onto harp holder (F) to secure harp in place.
- 5. Install bulbs. "C" version bulbs are included.
- 6. Slip shade (A), diffuser (B) and washer (C) onto threaded stud on top of harp (E). See Figure 2 for washer orientation.
- 7. Thread finial (D) onto threaded stud on harp (E) and tighten until snug. *Be careful not to over tighten.*

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
Installation Instructions

For Contract Antasia Table Lamps 272803 & 272803C


To Use Bolt-Down Option (Figures 3 & 4)

Component Parts

- G Fixture Base
- H Nipple
- I Washer
- J Hex Nut
- 1. Thread nipple (H) into coupling in bottom of fixture base (G).
- 2. In the surface that the lamp will bolt to, drill a 7/16" diameter hole for nipple (H) to slip through. See Figure 4 for alignment.
- 3. Slide nipple (H) through hole and make sure fixture base (G) is flush with the surface.
- 4. On the bottom side of the surface, place the washer (I) onto the nipple (H) and thread on the hex nut (J). Tighten to secure the lamp.
