





Install the Fixture



- Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2 Connect the fixture ground wire to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 3 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 4 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Properly place all wires and wire nut connections into the junction box/fixture base, mount the fixture onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place using the fixture screws.
- 6 Screw the lamps into the sockets. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage information.
- Install the shade to the shade base and secure it in place using the shade screws. Repeat for remaining shades.
