
Caution: Do not exceed maximum wattage noted on fixture. Use only recommended bulbs with fixture.

Prepare Fixture (Figure 1)

- 1. Carefully unpack all parts from the carton.
- 2. Locate base assembly (A) with base plate (B) attached.
- 3. Lay base assembly (A) on it's side on a soft surface to prevent damage to fixture finish.
- 4. Remove (3) flat head screws (C) from base assembly (A). Retain for later step.
- 5. Remove base plate (B) and lay next to base (A).


Caution: Be careful as plate (B) will still be attached with wires.

6. Follow steps on next page to continue fixture assembly.



Assemble Fixture (Figure 2)

- 1. Locate top assembly (E)
- 2. Carefully lay top assembly (E) on it's side near base assembly (A) as seen in Figure 2.
- 3. Run individual black and white socket wires from socket stems (F), through base tubes (G) until wires exit in base assembly (A).
- 4. Align pins in countersunk plate with holes in threaded plate.



- 6. In base assembly (A), locate white socket wires with connectors attached. They will be labeled A.
- 7. Locate white power wires that are also labeled A. Connect white socket wires and white power wires by pushing supplied connectors together until you hear a snap.
- 8. Repeat for black wires labeled B.

Caution: Be sure connectors are snapped together fully and no bare metal is exposed.

- 9. Tuck all wires into base assembly (A) and re-install base plate (B) using flat head screws (C).
- 10. Stand fixture upright and follow next steps to continue assembly.




To Install Dimmer Rod Figure 3)

- 1. Locate cover plate (I) and grommet (J).
- 2. Place cover plate (I) on countersunk plate.
- Install grommet (J) through all three plates to hold cover
 in place. A small flat head screw driver can aid in grommet install.
- Locate dimmer rod (L) which is shipped with knob attached.
- 5. Slide dimmer rod (L) through grommet (J) in cover plate (I).
- 6. Thread dimmer coupling (M) onto bottom of dimmer rod (L) and tighten securely.
- 7. Slide dimmer coupling (M) over dimmer (K) in base assembly (A) and secure in place by tightening set screw (N).

Note: It may be necessary to loosen set screw to allow coupling to slide onto dimmer.





Install Glass (Figures 4 & 5)

- 1. Carefully unpack glass (O)
- Sockets (P) are mounted on swivels; rotate sockets (P) until facing upward as seen in Figure 4
- 3. Carefully slide glass (O) over sockets (P) and set on top assembly (E).
- 4. Rotates swivels back to 90 degrees as seen in Figure 5.
- 5. If desired, clear rubber bumpons (R) can be installed to top assembly (E) to hold glass from rotating. See Figure 5.

Note: Do not place rubber bumpons underneath glass.

6. Plug in power cord.
