ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE (Fig. 1)

- 1. Shut off the power at the fuse box or circuit breaker. If necessary, remove old fixture, including mounting hardware.
- 2. Carefully remove the fixture from the carton and check that all parts are included as shown in the illustration.
- 3. Adjust the arms (E) to proper position.
- 4. Attach fixture loop (A) by screwing to nipple (H).

MOUNTING THE FIXTURE (Fig. 2)

- 5. Thread the nipple into the ceiling loop until snug.
- 6. Thread the other end of the nipple into the crossbar until snug. Note: The length of the nipple into the crossbar may be adjusted if necessary.
- 7. Place the lock washer and hex nut over the end of nipple protruding through crossbar. Then thread the hex nut onto the nipple until snug.
- Take this crossbar assembly and mount it to ceiling outlet box using the mounting screws (Size: #8-32N*L0.5"). The side of crossbar marked "GND" must face out.
- 9. Use proper chain pliers to open one end link of the chain and connect to the fixture loop. Then close the link.
- 10. By measuring, determine the correct number of links needed for the desired hanging height. Using the chain pliers, disconnect and discard the excess chain.
- 11. Carefully lace the fixture wires through the chain.
- 12. Slip the lock collar and canopy over the chain and allow them to rest on the fixture body.
- 13. Open the other end of the chain and attach it to the ceiling loop. Then close the chain.
- 14. Carefully feed the fixture wires through the ceiling loop and nipple and pull tight.
