

SILK LAMPSHADES CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

What you need:

- Water sprayer (filled with clean lukewarm water)
- Hairdryer
- Low speed vacuum cleaner, ideally a small hand held cordless vacuum cleaner or alternatively a soft brush.
- Piece of silk (provided by Venetia Studium upon request)
- Clean cloth

How to proceed:

Remove the lamp from the ceiling or wall attachment and place it on a flat, clean surface.

Begin by thoroughly removing the dust from the lampshade using the vacuum cleaner or the soft brush; This and the following actions should ONLY be performed on the inner side of the lamp and not on the decorated surface.

It is important to eliminate as much dust/dirt as possible from the silk as well as from the brass structure (in order to do so you can also use a clean cloth)

Using the sprayer, wet a small section of the lampshade and use the piece of silk provided to brush the damp section of the lamp.

Take now the hairdryer and start drying the lamp as quickly as possible, holding the hair dryer 10-15 cm away from the fabric.

Once the silk is completely dry you can repeat the whole process again on the rest of the lamp.

It is important while proceeding with this operation:

- a) not to use too much water;
- b) to work only on small areas
- c) to dry it as soon as possible to avoid any water stains

As soon as you've finished hang back the lamp on its attachment: you should immediately notice that your lamp looks as new and beautiful as when you first bought it
