MAINTENANCE

The Liberty Lounger

Your Liberty Lounger is completely made of solid Walnut that was imported under strict EUTR regulations. The chair was entirely produced in The Netherlands.

Wood is a natural product, every piece is different in color, grain and structure. Discoloration will appear over time under the influence of UV-light. Slight bending or minor surface cracks can appear as a result of environmental differences in temperature and humidity.

Never scratch or clean the Liberty Lounger with any fluid! All you should do is wipe it gently with a dust cloth. Over time the oil may wear out. In that case you can use the included maintenance kit. Follow the instructions in the package, use very little oil on your cloth and keep rubbing.

When the chair gets seriously stained, you could sand it with Scotch-Brite. This needs to be done in a very gentle way and always in the direction of the woodgrain. Consequently, apply your maintenance kit again as written above.

The sheepskin

Do not wash your sheepskin. Wool fiber breaks down substances naturally. The sheepskin can be combed with a soft hair brush. Regular whipping, by hand or with a carpet beater, is sufficient to enjoy your sheepskin for years to come.
