


ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Component Parts

- A Table**
- B Leg (4)**
- C Screw (16)**
- D Felt Pads (8)**
- E Clear Rubber Pads (9)**
- F Marble**




Cove Accent Table 750128

To Assemble Table Legs (Figure 1)

1. Carefully unpack table (A) and legs (B).
2. Position table upside down on flat surface. See orientation in Figure 1.
3. Screws (C) are shipping in kit bag. Locate screws before beginning assembly.
4. Place leg (B) up against corner of table (A). Line up holes in leg (B) block with plate on table (A).
5. Start (4) screws (C) in leg (B). Repeat for all remaining legs (B).
6. Once all table legs and screws are in place, tighten all screws (C).

Note: *Waiting to tighten screws will help with leg alignment.*

7. Depending on floor surface, adhere either felt pads (D) or clear rubber pad (E) to foot of each leg (B).

To Install Marble Top (Figure 2)

1. Flip over table (A).
2. Install rubber pads (E) on top table (A) surface. See recommended locations in Figure 2.
3. Carefully place marble (F) onto top of table. It should rest on rubber pads (E) and inside table legs (B).





Table Cleaning Instructions:

Use a dry soft cloth for dusting purposes, do not rub. Never scrub, use an abrasive, or any solvent-based cleaning products, as this could damage the finish. Wipe dry with soft cloth.

Marble Care Instructions:

Preventative: Use coasters under all glasses, particularly those containing alcohol or citrus juices, and place hot dishes on trivets

Spills: Immediately blot spills with a paper towel. Flush the area with a mix of warm water and mild dishwashing soap. Rinse several times. Dry the area thoroughly with a soft cloth. Repeat as necessary.

***Never use abrasive scrubbers or rough-woven cloths that could scratch marble. Do not use products containing lemon, vinegar, or other acids that will dull or etch marble surface. Stay away from scouring powders or abrasive creams and rust removers containing hydrofluoric acid; these will damage marble.**
