





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION MODEL #GEM-7007-MG-SS




All electrical components must be installed by a licensed electrician in accordance with the National Electric Code and the appropriate local electrical codes.



You will need 6 -Candelabra Base Bulb 40 Watts Recommended 60 Watts Max. **USE LED BULBS FOR EXTENDED USE**
THIS FIXTURE IS DAMP RATED



When hanging the crystal, start from this side.



Crystal Rod:

A 32 Pieces 160mm

C 34 Pieces 270mm

B 34 Pieces 215mm

1. Determine preferred hanging height and adjust to the required chain.
2. Feed the wires through the stem and screw the stem onto the top of the fixture. Hang the chain onto the loop on the top of the stem using a quick link.
3. Place the mounting plate over the outlet box, then mark points on the ceiling with the same distance between the holes on the mounting plate.
4. Drill the holes at the marked points then insert the plastic anchors into it.
5. Attach the mounting plate onto the outlet box and secure it with anchor screws.
6. Feed the wires and safety cable through the loop on the canopy. Run the safety cable through the outlet box and wrap the safety cable around the ceiling joist and secure the cable with the clamp and set screws provided as shown. Raise the fixture up to the ceiling and do the wire connections. Secure the canopy onto the mounting plate with the screws.
7. Insert the recommended bulbs(not included)
8. Hang the crystal rod onto the frame using the cap nuts.
