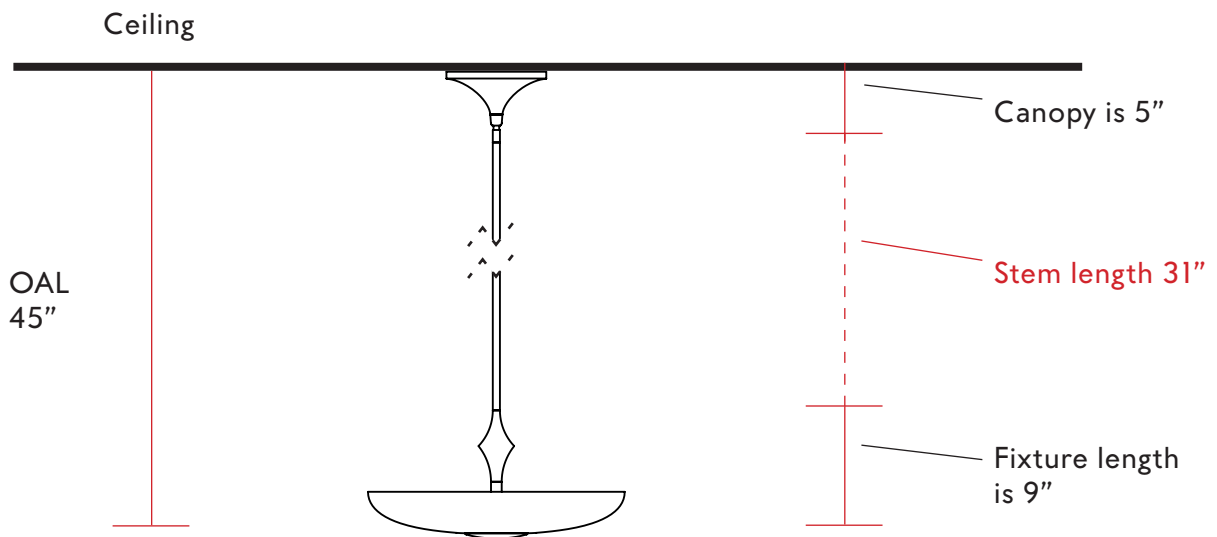
### Stem length adjustment

*Note: Please contact a licensed electrician.*

### Example fixture only:

To measure length of stem, first determine overall length (OAL), subtract 5" for the canopy height and subtract the fixture height from the OAL. Fixture height is measured from bottom of the fixture to stem connection point. The resulting measurement is the final stem length.

Ex. The fixture below has an OAL of 45" and a fixture height of 9".  
 $45" \text{ OAL} - 5" \text{ canopy} - 9" \text{ fixture height} = 31" \text{ Stem}$



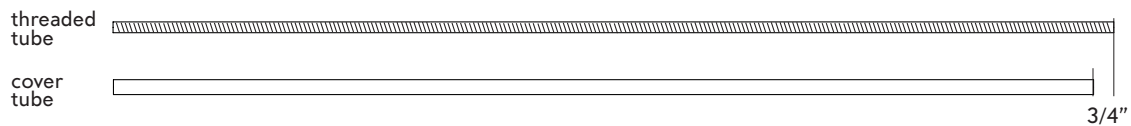

### Stem and cover tube length adjustment

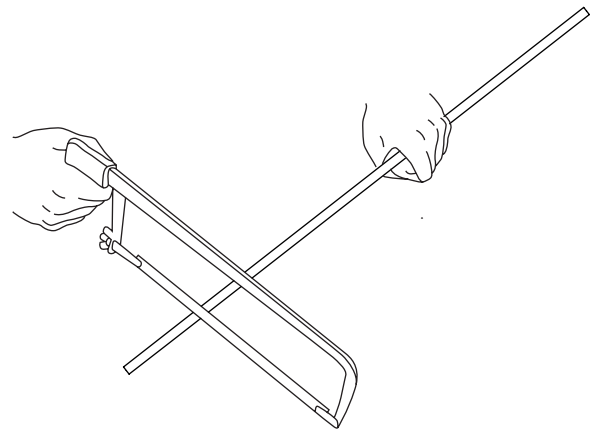

#### Example fixture only:

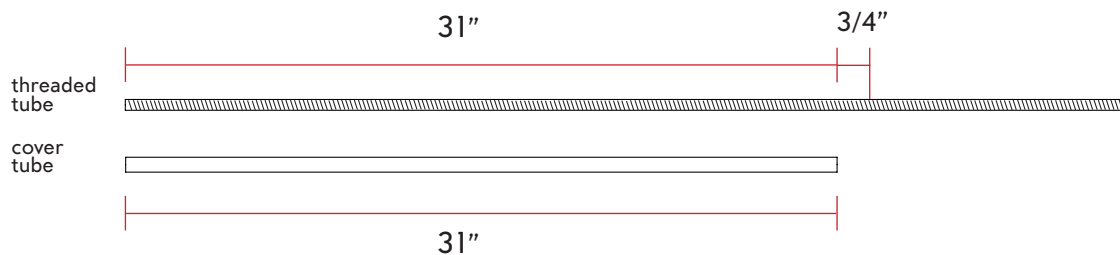
1. To customize the length of the provided stem, cut cover tube to desired length.  
Then cut the inner threaded tube so that it remains  $\frac{3}{4}$ " longer than the cover tube.



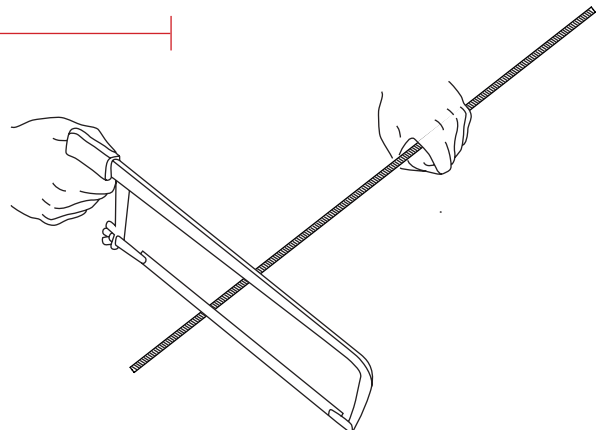
2. Mark the length of the tube required, using a marker or tape. Then hold down the tube with a hand or a clamp, use a hacksaw or electrical tool to cut the tube. Recommended to clean tube after cutting to remove any metal chippings.



3. Now that the cover tube is cut to 31", measure the all thread tube to be 31 and  $\frac{3}{4}$ " long. And place a mark, with a marker or tape.



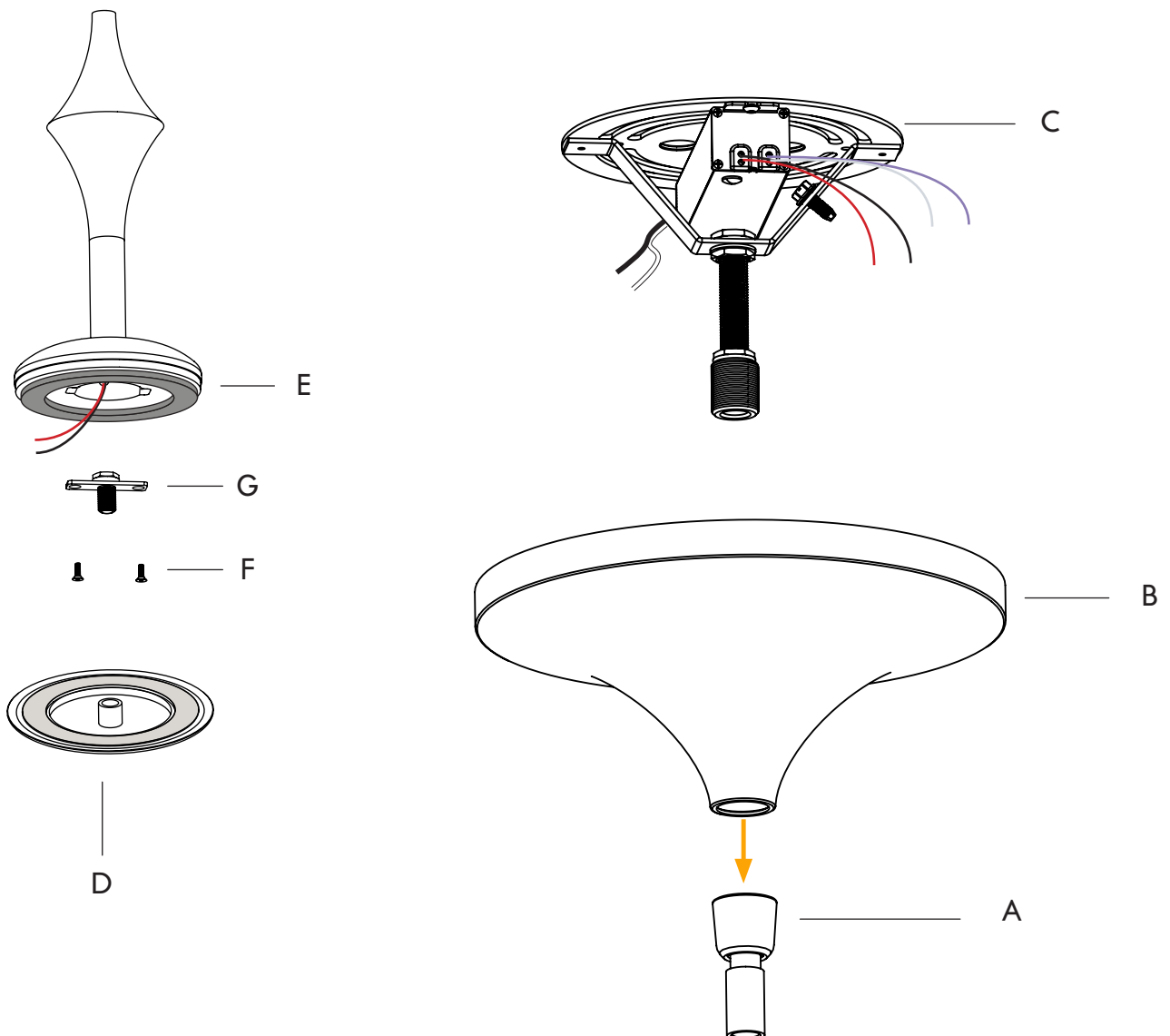
4. Hold down the all thread with a hand or a clamp, use a hacksaw or electrical tool to cut the all thread tube. Recommended to clean all thread tube after cutting to remove any metal chippings.



## MET PENDANT | INSTALLATION

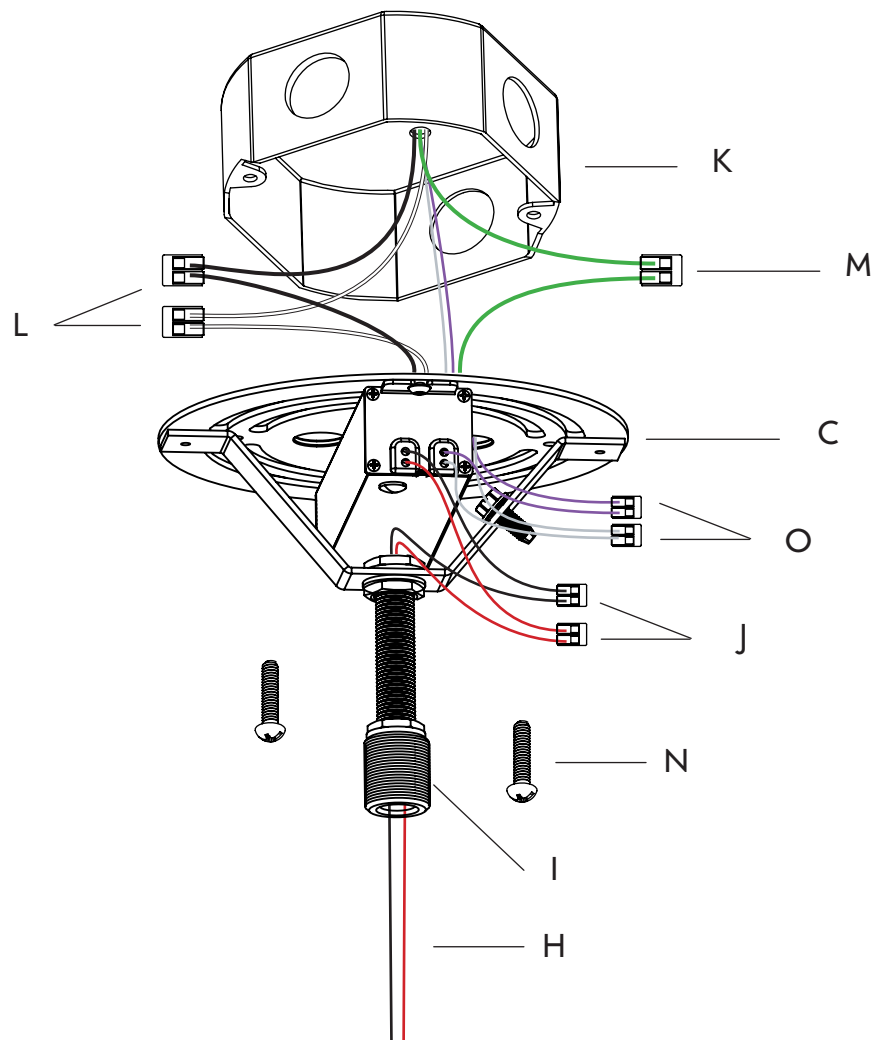
01. Unscrew the threaded hang-straight nut (A) from the canopy (B), to release the crossbar assembly (C).
02. Unscrew the glass cap (D) from the main fixture body (E).
03. Unscrew the two hex screws (F) to release the bracket (G).



## MET PENDANT | INSTALLATION

*Note: Please contact a licensed electrician for installation. Ensure power is off during installation.*

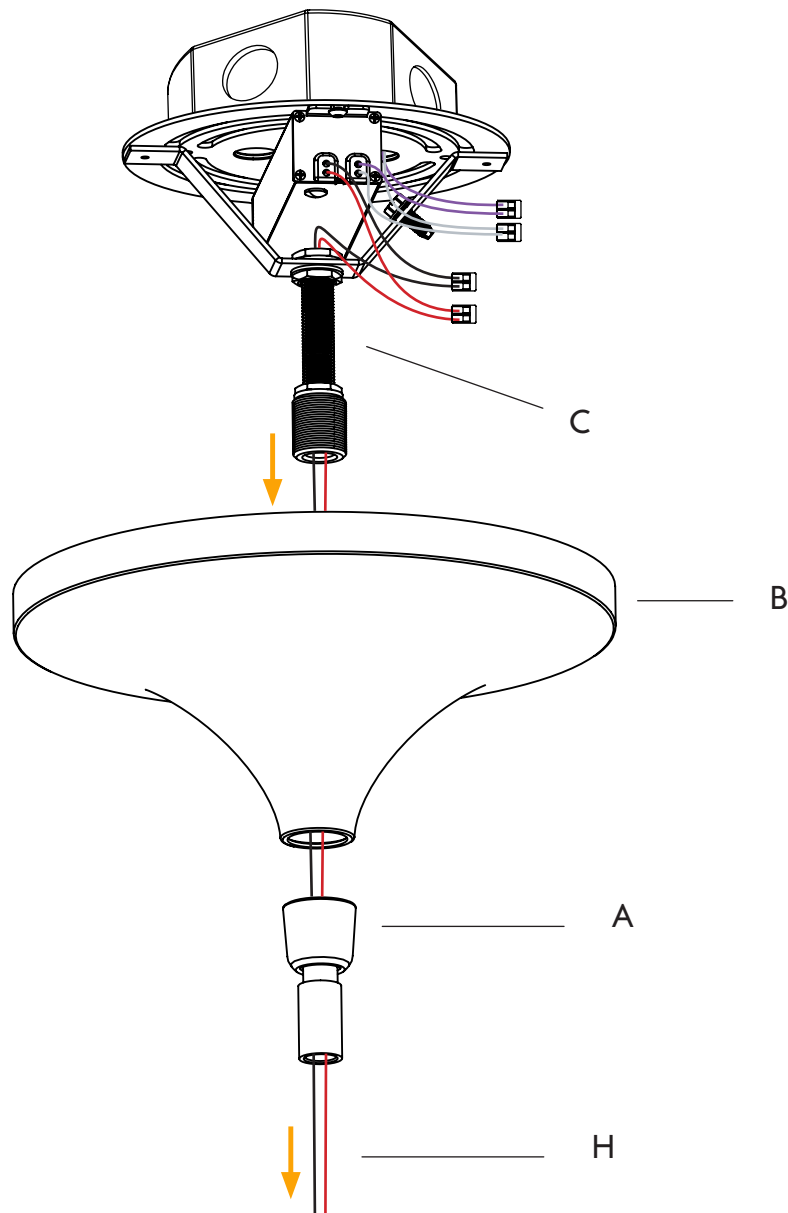
04. Take the provided spool of low voltage wires (H) and pull it through the crossbar assembly nipple (I).
05. Make the low voltage wire connection with the provided 2-port wagos (J).
06. Bring the crossbar assembly (C) up to the J-box (K), and make lead wire connection with provided 2-port wagos (L),
07. Make the ground wire connection with the provided 2-port wago (M).
08. Pull the dimming wires from the J-box, through the center hole of the crossbar assembly, Then secure the crossbar assembly to J-box using the two provided screws (N)  
Be sure to tuck the lead wire and ground wire connections inside the J-box.
09. Optional: make the dimming connection with the provided 2-port wagos (O).

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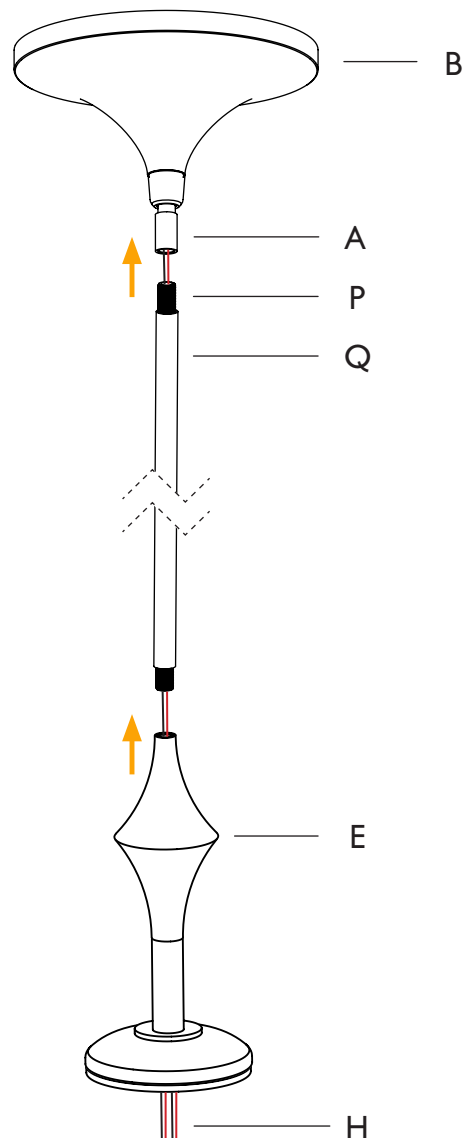
10. Next, pull the low voltage wires (H) from the crossbar assembly (C), through the canopy (B) and threaded hang-straight nut (A).
11. Tuck the low voltage wire connections and the dimming wire connections inside the canopy (B), and secure the canopy over the crossbar assembly with threaded hang-straight nut.



## MET PENDANT | INSTALLATION

*Note: Please contact a licensed electrician for installation. Ensure power is off during installation.*

11. Pull the low voltage wires (H) from the canopy (B), through the threaded rod (P), and cover tube (Q), and screw in the threaded rod into the hang-straight nut (A)
12. Then pull the low voltage wires (H) through the fixture assembly (E) and screw in the fixture assembly onto the threaded rod.

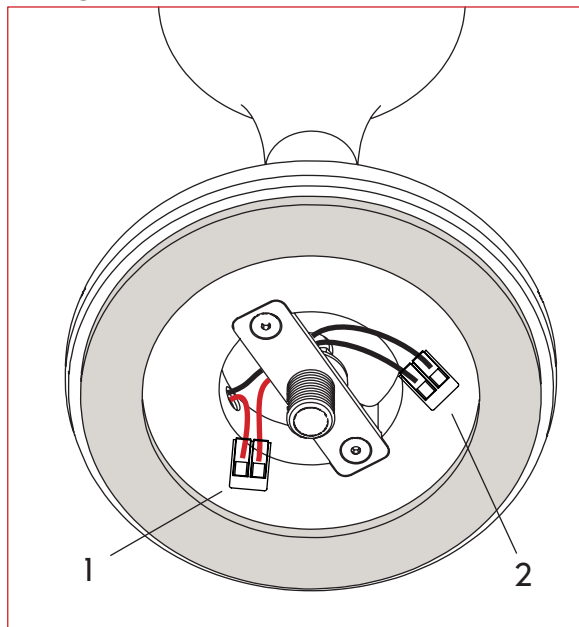


## MET PENDANT | GLASS INSTALLATION

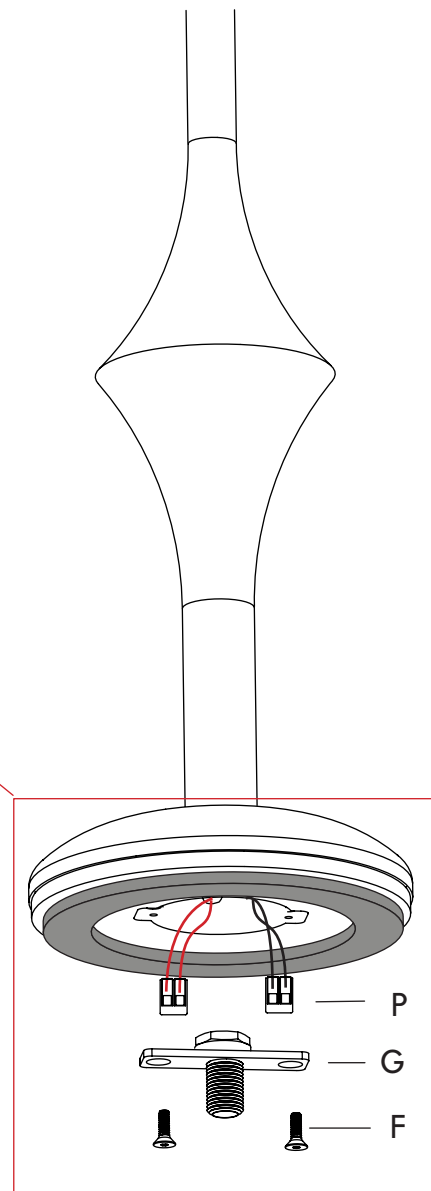
*Note: Please contact a licensed electrician for installation. Ensure power is off during installation.*

13. Cut the low voltage wires to 1-2in and make the connection with the provided 2-port wagos (P).  
Once connected, tuck in the wagos inside the crevice space.
14. Then secure the bracket (G) with the two hex screws (F). Make sure that each connected wire set is on opposite side of the bracket to fit the wagos, see diagram 1 below.

## MET PENDANT | GLASS INSTALLATION

*Note: Please contact a licensed electrician for installation. Ensure power is off during installation.*

14. Install the Glass shade (R), by aligning the hole on the glass, with the threaded nipple (S) on the fixture. Then secure the glass with a glass cap (D).

NOTE: while screwing in the glass cap, some adjustments to the glass may be needed to center it in order for the glass to be leveled.
