#### TO POWER ON/OFF

Touch the light post anywhere above the line on the post to operate. A quick touch will turn the light on and off.

#### TO ADJUST BRIGHTNESS


Touching and holding the light post anywhere above the line on the post will adjust the continuous dimming.

NOTE: Shade is not adjustable.


# Step 1

Remove the light from the box and place on desired surface.


# Step 2

Connect the light to the provided power supply and plug the power supply into a 120V source.




### Tools needed:

3-1/2" diameter hole saw 5/32" allen wrench

## Step 1


Prepare the surface by cutting a 3-1/2" diameter hole in the worksurface. Remove the light from the box and route the power cord through the hole in the worksurface. Place the lamp into the hole, being mindful to not pinch the cord.





From the underside of the worksurface, install the lower clamp using the provided 1/4"-20 Button Head Screws. Use a 5/32" allen wrench to tighten the two screws until the clamp holds firmly to the underside of the worksurface.

USB version only: Rotate lamp to align USB ports to the desired postion prior to tightening screws.



Pro Tip: It can be helpful to have a second person hold the light in place while clamping to ensure orientation stays as desired and the light does not fall over.

# Step 3

Connect the light to the provided power supply and plug the power supply into a 120V source.
