# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

# C-10680 Capricorn Sconce

#### IMPORTANT!

AT ALL TIMES WIRING TO BE DONE PER NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODES (NEC) OR APPLICABLE LOCAL CODES. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY. TURN OFF POWER AT CIRCUIT BREAKER OR FUSE BOX BEFORE PROCEEDING.

#### STEP 1

• Carefully remove fixture from packaging. Avoid using a sharp blade on the packaging, as doing so may result in damage to the fixture, shade, or finish.

## STEP 2

• Turn off power at fuse box or circuit breaker.

## STEP 3




Figure 1 Figure 2

- Remove mounting disk. Secure to outlet box with screws provided. (Figure 1)
- Studs protruding from mounting disk should be horizontal and level. Adjust if necessary.
- Temporarily place sconce over mounting disk and mark upper backplate hole location with pencil.
- Remove sconce. Install wall anchor at pencil mark.

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#### STEP 4

- Make wire connections using twist-on connectors. (Figure 2)
- Connect the white fixture lead to the neutral supply wire (typically white).
- Connect the black fixture lead to the hot supply wire (typically black).
- Connect the copper fixture wire to the ground wire or ground terminal in the outlet box.
- Push all connections inside the outlet box.

#### STFP 5

- Mount sconce to wall by aligning over studs, and tightening knurled knobs. (Figure 3)
- Secure screw into wall anchor at top of backplate.

# STEP 6

• Install lamp into socket. See fixture label for maximum wattage rating. (Figure 4)

## STEP 7

- Install shade onto sconce. (Figure 5)
- Secure with threaded white cap.

### STEP 8

- Install top cap above shade. (Figure 6)
- Secure in place with color-matched screw.

## STEP 9

• The metal caps (shown in red) at top and bottom of shade should be evenly exposed. (Figure 7)

# STEP 10

- Shade and top cap positions can be adjusted by loosening the bracket screws (shown in red).
- After adjusting one or both brackets, re-tighten screws.
