# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

C-10751 Spire Sconce

## **IMPORTANT!**

AT ALL TIMES WIRING TO BE DONE PER NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODES (NEC) OR APPLICABLE LOCAL CODES. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY. TURN OFF POWER AT CIRCUIT BREAKER OR FUSE BOX BEFORE PROCEEDING.

## STEP 1

• Carefully remove fixture components from packaging. Avoid using a sharp blade on the packaging, as doing so may result in damage to the fixture or finish. Shade is porcelain. Handle with care.

## STEP 2

- Remove mounting bracket from fixture (Figure 1)
- Using a hex key, loosen set screws at top and bottom of backplate. Do not remove entirely.

## STEP 3

- Make main wire connections using included orange twist-on connectors. (Figure 2)
- Connect the white fixture lead to the neutral supply wire (typically white).
- Connect the black fixture lead to the hot supply wire (typically black).
- Connect the copper fixture wire to the ground wire or ground terminal in the electrical box.

- The standard driver is **non-dimmable**.
- Driver is semi-recessed. Fixture must be mounted onto a 3.50" wide octagonal electrical box.
- Optional dimmable drivers are required to be mounted remotely.

## STEP 4

• Secure mounting bracket to electrical box with the provided screws (Figure 2)

- Using provided twist-on style connectors, connect fixture wiring to the driver (Figure 3)
- Connect the red (+) fixture lead to the red (+) driver wire.
- Connect the black (-) fixture lead to the black (-) driver wire.
- Tuck connections into driver pocket.

## STEP 6

STEP 5

- Align fixture over mounting bracket (Figure 3)
- Secure fixture by tightening the top and bottom set screws.
- Give fixture a gentle tug to be sure it is being held firmly in place.

## STEP 7

• Gently rotate tapered rod about ¼ turn counter-clockwise (see arrow) so that screw holes on backside of rod can be seen (Figure 4)

## STEP 8

- Carefully place porcelain shade on rod. Upper shade should be "hooked" over the tip of the rod.






Figure 5 Figure 6

- Secure shade to rod with screw and white rubber O-ring (Figure 5). Screw requires a hex key.
- Do not over-tighten as this may crack the porcelain shade.

# STEP 9

- If screw hole on shade does not properly align with the tapped hole in the tapered rod, remove shade and adjust set screw on tip of rod (Figure 6).
- Secure porcelain shade onto rod (Figures 7/8).

# STEP 10

• Rotate rod back into the original position so that back of shade is directly facing the wall.

## STEP 11

• Restore power to fixture.
