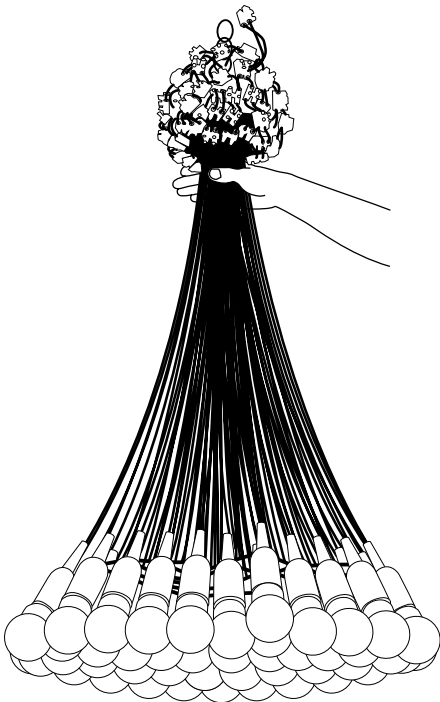


85 lamps - US DIMMABLE LED 110V

MAKE SURE THE ELECTRICITY IS DISCONNECTED WHEN INSTALLING THE PRODUCT.

1. Preparing for use

The bulbs are included and most of them are already fitted in the lamp fixture. Hold the 85 lamps just underneath the connectors at the metal ring when lifting the 85 lamps. Do not lift it by its wires.

2. Installation

Ensure that NO electricity is running through the cables when installing the 85 lamps. Mount the 85 lamps using the metal ring and a firmly mounted hook that can carry a weight of at least 15 kg. For your safety, make sure the connectors cannot be reached by hand from the ground.

The wires may have become twisted during shipping and handling. Hang the lamp and keep it switched on for several hours. After a few days the wires will return to their original shape. If a whole section of bulbs doesn't light up when the lamp is switched on, it is possible that a connector is loose, ask a certified electrician to check the connections.

PLEASE NOTE:

The LED-bulbs supplied with this lamp can be dimmed and this 85 lamps is not suitable for electronic switches. Dimmable with a normal incandescent light bulb dimmer, called Leading edge TRIAC dimming.

3. Changing the bulb

Before removing the bulb, first allow the 85 lamps to cool off completely to avoid burns. The 85 lamps comes with 2 extra bulbs, also the bulbs can be purchased at your Droog dealer (in a set of 5 pcs.).

4. Maintenance

Before cleaning the 85 lamps fixture let it cool completely. Clean the 85 lamps carefully with a clean, dry cloth/feather duster. Don't use water or detergents.

5. Safety

Keep the 85 lamps out of reach of children and animals. The 85 lamps can cause burns. Never use the 85 lamps in other means than by the lamp's normal operation. The 85 lamps is only to be used indoors. Avoid contact with moisture and/or humid spaces. This can cause a short circuit. Do not expose the 85 lamps to immediate sunlight. Do not bring the 85 lamps into contact with other synthetics, liquids and fats. When storing the 85 lamps, make sure the bulbs are protected for breakage. It is preferable to store it hanging. Make sure that the lamp is disconnected before changing the bulbs or doing anything else with the lamp (e.g. moving or cleaning it). Do not use the 85 lamps if any part of it is damaged. Check the 85 lamps regularly for damage. Repairs to the fittings or cables are only to be carried out by authorised, qualified electrician. The 85 lamps is only intended for use with the voltage indicated on the type plate (110V / 60 Hz). Never cover the 85 lamps. This could cause a fire.
