Theia Table Lamp - Floor Model

Description

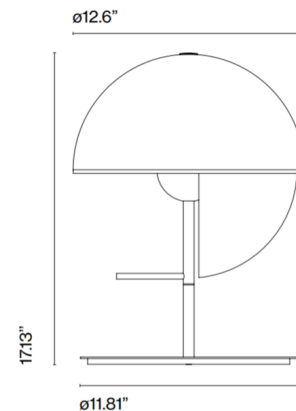
Theia Table Lamp, designed by Mathias Hahn, is elementary and streamlined with two half-spheres, one placed horizontally and the other vertically, which intersect with each other. Just as in nature itself, these formal elements make it possible for the light from a source to be simultaneously projected, reflected, and absorbed by objects for our visual enjoyment. Theia has two faces: to discover them, simply swivel the fixture around its central axis. It can be pointed towards you for use as a reading lamp, or towards an object or a wall, creating a subtle, indirect light that immediately warms the atmosphere. Because Theia's metal lampshade is totally opaque, this swiveling movement totally shifts the perception of the piece. Base and stem available in Black, vertical semi-sphere in lacquered spun metal with interior in white, and a transparent smoke shade in methacrylate. Black cord with progressive dimmer.
