The Gropius Low Chair is named after Walter Gropius, the German architect and co-founder of the influential Bauhaus school and pays homage to his pioneering work in modern design. The Bauhaus movement is known for objects and buildings composed of simple geometric forms and a focus on the intersection of functionalism and artistic expression. These design principles are still relevant today and are reflected in the chair's combination of circular and cylindrical forms. The chair possesses a sculptural elegance that remains playful and inviting for more casual spaces. The seat and backrest are filled with a foam cushion fill, making Gropius as comfortable as it is stylish.
